

Is the PresSURE-OFF this system??



Replace or repair the Drop . . . NOT the:

The *simple* way to determine if the system you are about to work on has been shut off and drained:

1. Clamp PresSURE-OFF **TESTER** to drop or other 1" pipe
2. Connect cordless drill onto the sealed, built-in drill bit
3. Drill into piping
4. Pressurized systems will indicate on gauge with no water leakage
5. The built-in hose adapter allows for system pressure relief and drain
